Because the two requests were straightforward with little reason for discussion, the committee was notified by email. Six of the nine members responded positively to recommend approval of both requests.

**Requests**

**Unit 827:** Remove the tree beside the unit. It has a fungus and ought to be cut down. The homeowner would like a Japanese Maple considered as a replacement but agrees that other types may be more appropriate. The homeowner offers to pay \$100 towards the new tree. Also, the homeowner thanks Dick Koob and David Rollins for cutting out the bush behind her unit. (This bush appeared on the June 2008 walkaround as one which needed attention.)

**The committee recommends approval with the following stipulation: the replacement tree will be chosen considering its placement near the unit, its expected longevity, and its impact on the existing environment. The homeowner, Architectural and Grounds Committees should be involved with this decision.**

**Unit 833:** Replace the existing skylight when the roof is redone. It is a Velux fixed skylight. The new skylight will be the same style and construction as the existing skylight.

**The committee recommends approval.**
