**Requests**

**Unit 854**

A letter of request from the owner of unit 854 currently being rented by the Sisters of St. Francis was forwarded to me for Architectural Committee consideration. The letter is attached. I have also prepared and attached the form used for such requests for to accompany the letter.

Replacement of the cracked patio: The owner asks if they could use regular concrete in place of the exposed aggregate now in place.

**The committee recommends the surface be replaced with exposed aggregate.** One Architectural Committee member submitted such a request in the past and at that time the committee decided the replacement surface should be aggregate. We believe this offers continuity throughout the community and such a restriction assures that other surfaces such as concrete pavers will not be used.

Lifting of the entry sidewalk:

I have looked at this area and find that the sidewalk is raised enough to be a hazard.

**The committee recommends this issue be referred to the board for its consideration at the time when other such issues are addressed.**
